1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc. (YA) – Part 1 Category 5.
- 1.3 No crew weighing
- 1.4 Farr 30: Maximum crew on board will be 7
- 1.5 Farr 40: Are required to race within the *spirit* of the one-design rule

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all Farr 40 Type and Farr 30 Type boats.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee to by no later than 1700 Saturday 4 September 2010:

3. FEES

Required fees are as follows:

Includes 7 BBQ tickets for the 27-28 November 2010 BBQ

5. MEASUREMENTS

Each eligible IRC boat shall produce a valid 2010 IRC Certificate.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7. VENUE

The venue is Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron, 578 Royal Esplanade, Manly QLD 4179.

8. THE COURSES

All courses will be Windward/Return as per Attachment 1

9. SCORING

13.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.

13.2 Six (6) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.3 When ten (10) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12. PRIZES & DIVISIONS

Prizes will be given as follows:

19.1 Farr 40 Scratch 1st, 2nd and 3rd

19.2 Farr 30 Scratch 1st, 2nd and 3rd

19.3 Mixed Fleet IRC – 1st, 2nd and 3rd

19.4 Minimum three (3) entries to establish a division.

13. DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5m per event or equivalent.

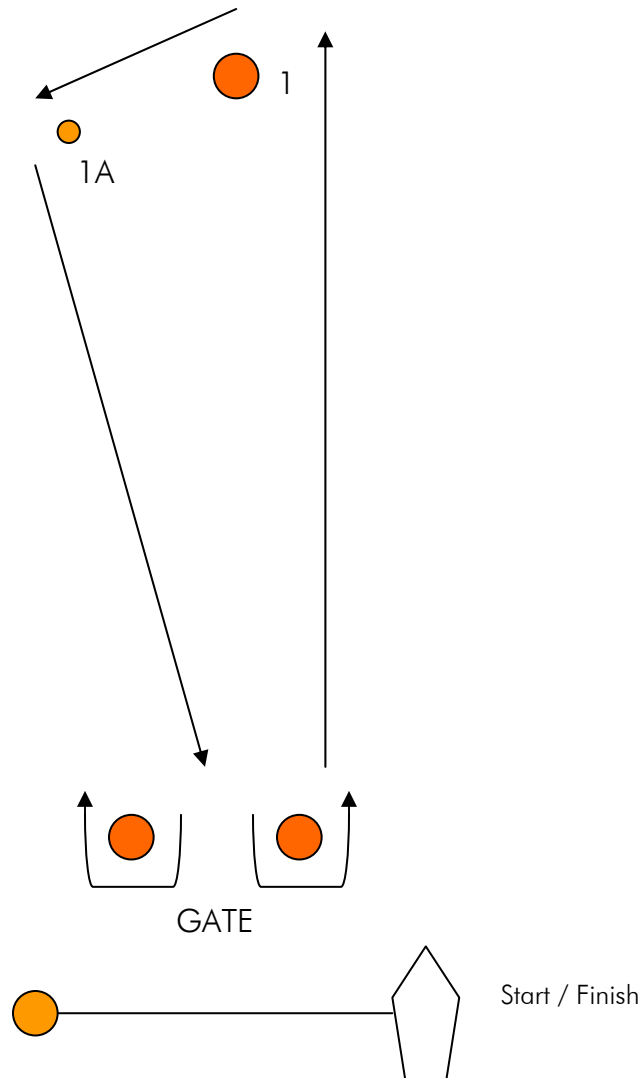
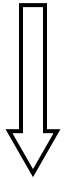
