1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc. (YA) – Part 1 Category 5.
- 1.3 Where lifelines complying with YA SR Part 1 Section 3 Rule 3.12 have not been fitted, all crew while racing shall wear a visible personal floatation device as per YA SR Part 1 Section 5.
- 1.4 Any class rules

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Monohull and Multihull boats on the register of a yacht or sailing club affiliated with a state yachting authority.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee to by no later than midnight Tuesday 31 May 2011:

- 2.4 Late entries will be accepted however will incur a late fee.

3. FEES

5. MEASUREMENTS

- 5.1 Each eligible IRC boat shall produce a valid 2009 IRC Certificate.
- 5.2 Each eligible SMS boat shall produce a valid SMS Certificate.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be the 2011 Manly Combined Clubs Sailing Instructions.

7. VENUE

The host club is Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron in conjunction with RQYS Canaipa.

8. THE COURSES

Attachment 1 shows the courses to be sailed.

9. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.

Please Note: Saturday 4 June Myora Cup Race is a single race event. Points for Manly Combined Clubs Race 6 and Race 7 will go towards the overall Manly Combined Clubs Series.

10. BERTHING / HARDSTAND

For RQYS Marina Berths or Hardstand spaces please contact the Marina Office on 07 3393 3554 during business hours.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12. PRIZES & DIVISIONS

Prizes will be given as follows:

- 12.1 The Myora Cup E N Ham Trophy will be awarded to first place on IRC.
- 12.2 1st Division 1
- 12.3 The Nathan Cup will be awarded to the first place Division 2 Boat.
- 12.4 1st SMS
- 12.5 1st Multihulls
- 12.6 A minimum of five (5) entries constitutes a division.

13. DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5m per event or equivalent.

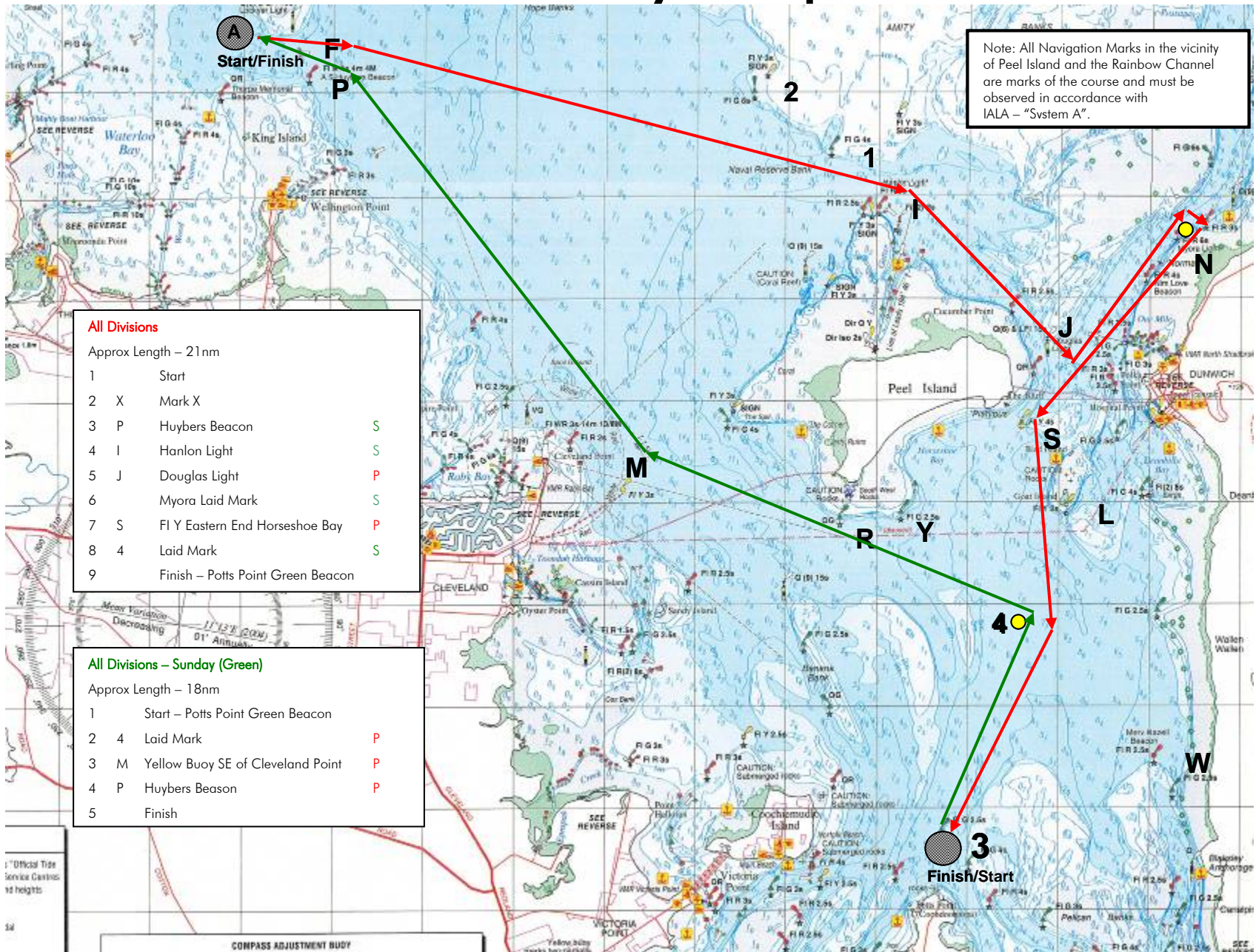
