1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc. (YA) – Part 2.
- 1.3 Any class rules
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 All advertising will be in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to the following international classes:
 - International Optimist
 - Laser 4.7
 - Laser Radial (Girls and Boys)
 - International 420 (Girls and Boys)
 - 29er
 - Sailboard (Girls and Boys)
 - BicTechno (Girls and Boys)
 - Hobie 16
 - O'pen Bic
- 3.2 The regatta is open to the following national classes:
 - Sabot 1up and 2up
 - Pacer
 - Flying Eleven
- 3.3 All competitors shall apply with rule 46 and 55.
- 3.4 All competitors shall be under 19 years as of 31 December 2011.
- 3.5 Proof of age and Yachting Australia membership shall be required.
- 3.6 The signed Code of Conduct Agreement shall be received at or by the time of registration.
- 3.7 When entry is accepted details will be displayed on www.qldyouthweek.com
- 3.8 Eligible boats may be entered completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee to by no later than 1700 Sunday 12 June 2011:

- 3.10 Late entries will be accepted however will incur a late fee.

6. MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall comply with the relevant measurement criteria as per their class rules.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration. Sailing Instructions may be available earlier via the official website – www.qldyouthweek.com

8. VENUE

8.1 Attachment 1 shows the location of the regatta harbour.

8.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing area.

9. THE COURSES

The courses will be trapezoid with inner and outer loops, windward/returns or triangles. All courses will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 Rule 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty except for infringements that occur within three boat lengths of a rounding mark.
- 10.2 Appendix P will apply as changed by instruction 10.1 and 10.3.
- 10.3 Rule P2.3 will not apply and rule P.2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 11.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3 (a) When six (6) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
(b) When from seven (7) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
(c) When nine (9) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with a white flag with the numbers to identify which boat they are representing. All support boats are required to register at the regatta registration to obtain this flag.

13. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14. TELEVISION AND MEDIA

Attendance at a media/press conference each day may be required for the top three competitors as well as individual heat winners. Suitable notification will be given.

15. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participation in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at the discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for said event in which the competitor participated and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

16. PRIZES & DIVISIONS

Prizes will be given as follows:

- 16.1 Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class/division.
- 16.2 An overall prize for the top ranked state will be awarded based on the overall results from the three highest ranked individual results.
- 16.3 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the race committee.
- 16.4 Minimum six (6) entries to establish a class/division.

17. DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5m per event or equivalent.

Spectator Boat	<p>A spectator boat may be available for each day of the regatta. Further details will be provided on the regatta website if this is going ahead.</p>

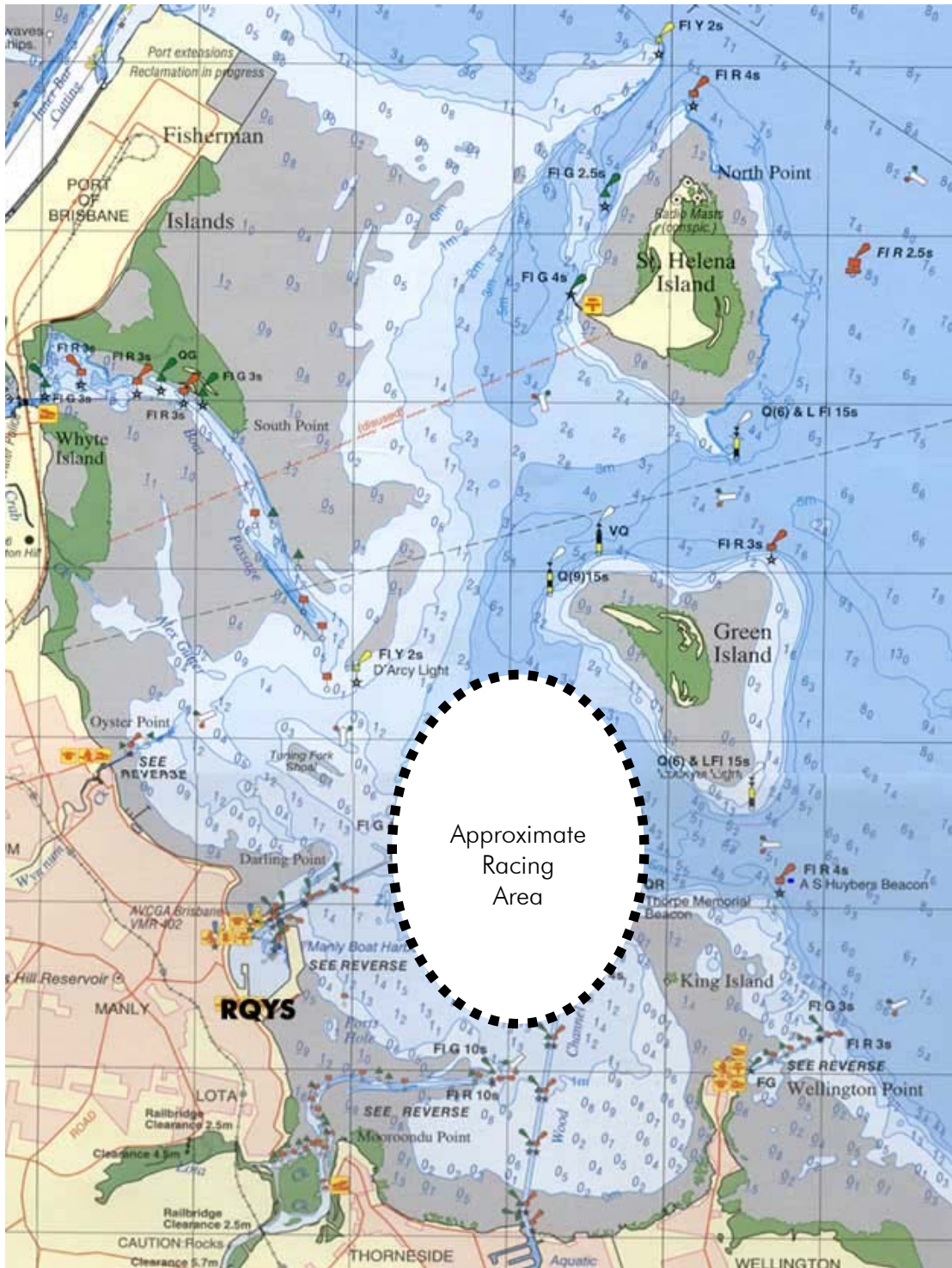
ATTACHMENT 1
