1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No National prescriptions will apply
- 1.3 The rules of respective class associations.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 All advertising will be in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to the following International Classes:
 - Finn
 - Laser Standard – Open
 - Laser Radial – Open, Women, Boys Youth and Girls Youth
 - Laser 4.7
 - 49er
 - Star
 - International 470 – Men and Women
 - International 420 – Open, Boys Youth and Girls Youth
 - 29er – Open and Open Youth
 - RSX
 - BicTechno – Boys and Girls
 - International Optimist
 - Hobie 16 – Open and Open Youths
- 3.2 National Classes: All National Classes wishing to participate in Sail Brisbane are requested to contact Yachting Queensland on +61 7 3393 6788 or email office@qldyachting.org.au.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter online via www.sailbrisbane.com or by completing the attached form.
- 3.4 Entries close at midnight Wednesday 9th November 2011.
- 3.5 Late entries will be accepted however will incur a late fee.

4. FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:
 - Single Handed Classes - \$190.00
 - All Other Classes - \$250.00
 - Late Entry Fee Surcharge - \$50.00
- 4.2 Entry fees are stated in Australian AUD\$ and include GST and presentation sausage sizzle.
- 4.3 Entries include a Regatta T-Shirt. Additional shirts can be purchased for AUD\$20.00 each.
- 4.4 Entries cancelled in the week preceding the event will not be refunded. If cancellation occurs prior to this date 75% of the fee will be refunded upon receipt of a written request.

5.1 The full schedule of races will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

5.2 No warning signal will be made after 1500 hours on Saturday 19 November 2011.

6. MEASUREMENTS

6.1 Each boat shall hold a valid measurement certificate which may be required at any time. (Not applicable for Laser, 49er, 29er, Hobie 16 or Optimist classes.)

6.2 Random measurement checks and safety inspections may be carried out at any time, and a boat or crew which fails such inspection may be liable to protest the decision on any penalty shall be at the discretion of the Jury and could be disqualification from all races sailed on the day prior to the inspection.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on Wednesday 16 November 2011. Sailing Instructions may be posted on the official website prior to this date.

8. VENUE

8.1 Attachment 1 shows the location of the regatta harbour.

8.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing areas.

9. THE COURSES

The courses will be trapezoid with inner and outer loops, triangles or windward/leeward. All courses will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 49er, 29er and Hobie 16 only: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10.2 Appendix P will apply as changed by instructions 10.1.

11. SCORING

11.1 Five (5) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2 When five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11.3 When from six (6) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11.4 When from nine (9) to ten (10) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with a white flag with the numbers to identify which boat they are representing. The numbers shall be supplied by the Organizing Authority. All support boats are required to register at Registration on Sunday 28 November or Monday 29 November 2010 to obtain this flag.

13. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned berth in the RQYS Marina.

14. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

15. DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

17. TELEVISION AND MEDIA

Attendance at a media/press conference each day may be required for the top three competitors as well as individual heat winners. Suitable notification will be given.

18. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at the discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for said event in which the competitor participated and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

19. PRIZES

19.1 Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third in each division providing more than six (6) entries are received before the closing date.

19.2 Prizes will be awarded to first place in each division when there are less than six (6) entries received before the closing date.

20. DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

21. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5m per event or equivalent.

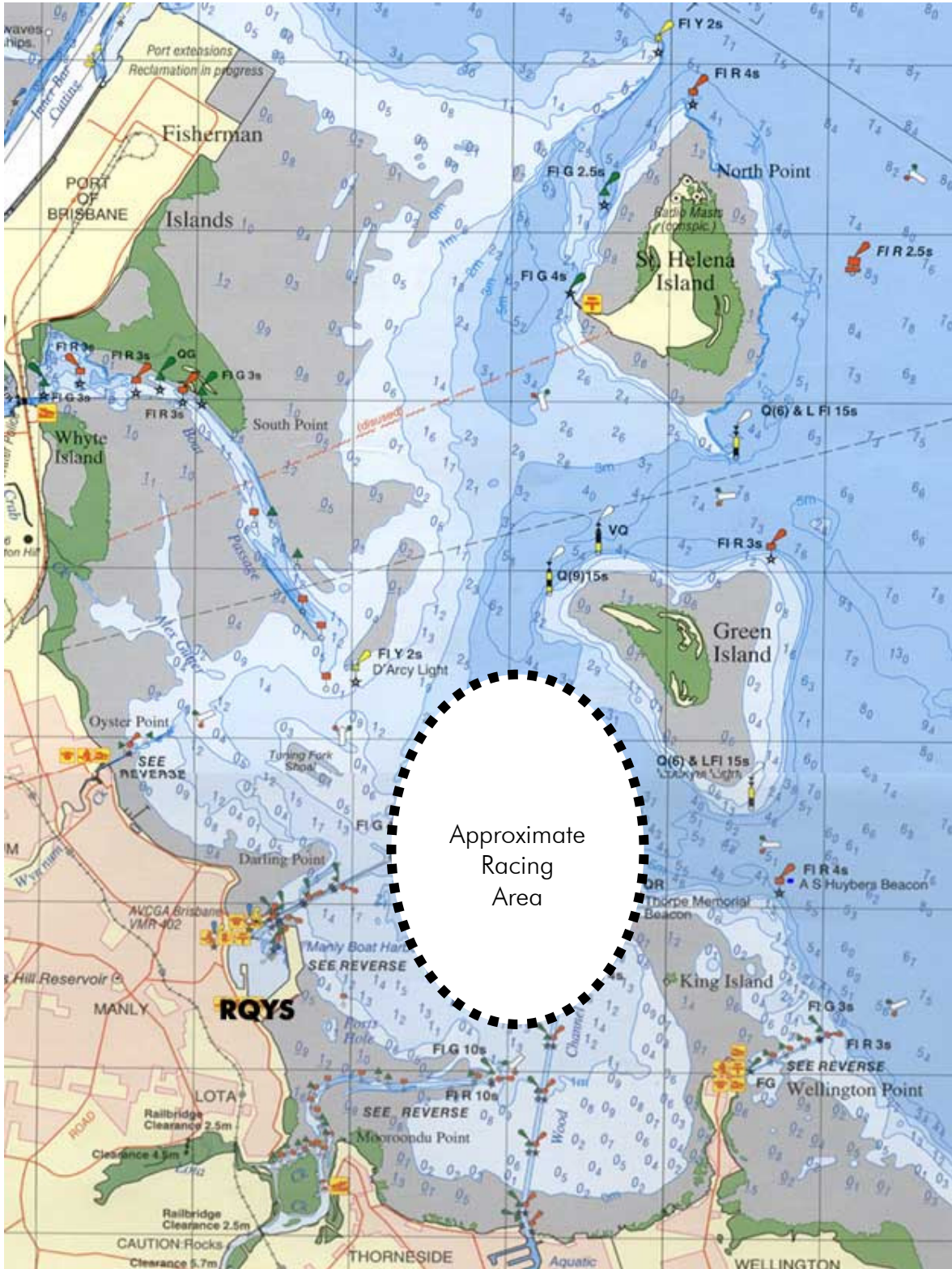
ATTACHMENT 1
