1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc. (YA) – Part 2
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category C.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all International 420s on the register of a yacht or sailing club.
- 3.2 All competitors shall apply with rule 46 and 55.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee by no later than 1700 Friday 15 May 2009 to:

- 3.4 Online entries can be made via <http://enter.rqys.com.au>.
- 3.5 Late entries will be accepted however will incur a late fee.

4. FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:
420 - \$50.00 per boat
- 4.2 Additional fees:
Late fee surcharge - \$20.00 on top of entry fee.

6. MEASUREMENTS

Each 420 must have a valid measurement certificate.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting.

8. VENUE

- 8.1 The host club is Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron – 578 Royal Esplanade Manly QLD 4179.
- 8.2 Racing will be conducted on Moreton Bay west of Green Island.

9. THE COURSES

The diagram in Attachment 1 shows the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

10. SCORING

- 10.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 10.2 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 (a) When 5 or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races scores.
(b) When 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst result.

11. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with a white flag with the numbers to identify which boat they are representing. All support boats are required to register to obtain this flag.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. PRIZES & DIVISIONS

- 13.1 Queensland Perpetual Trophy – 1st Queensland registered boat
- 13.2 1st, 2nd and 3rd Overall
- 13.3 1st, 2nd and 3rd Youth Boys
- 13.4 1st, 2nd and 3rd Youth Girls
- 13.5 Coaches Award

14. DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5m per event or equivalent.

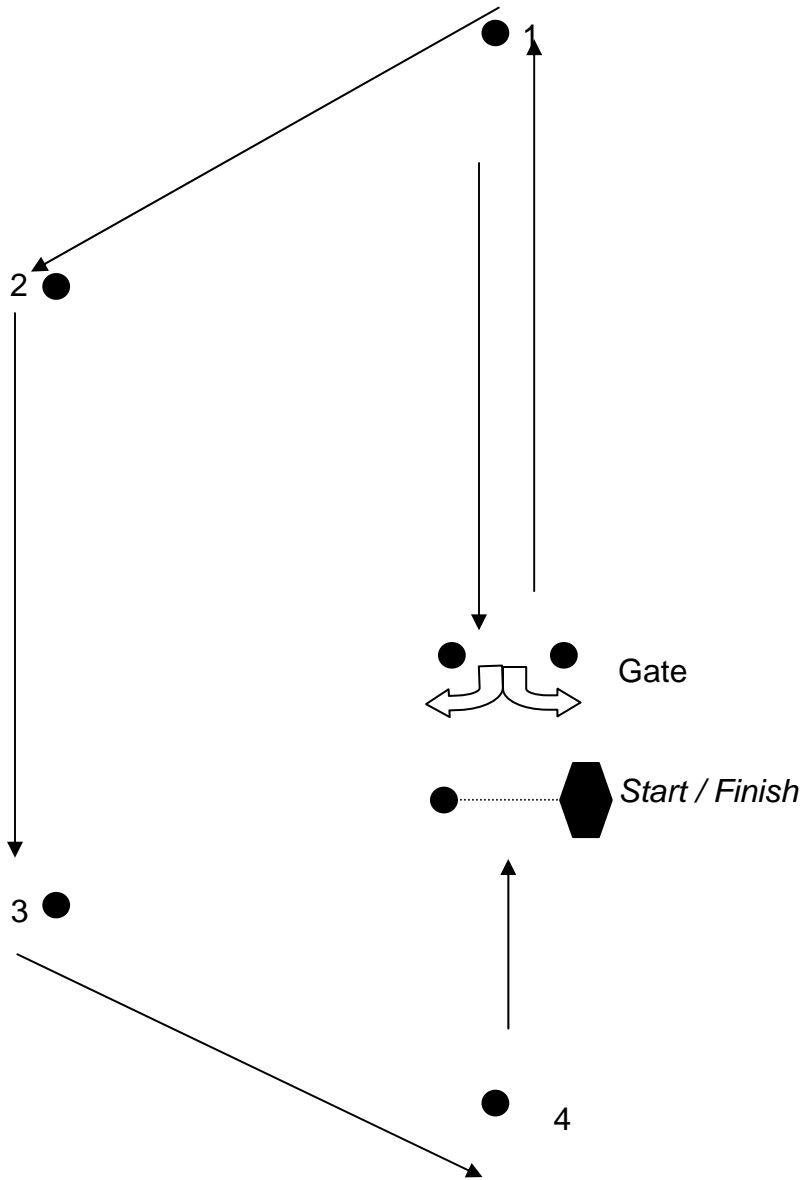
