1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc. (YA) – Part 2
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages then English text will take precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all off-the-beach classes on the register of a yacht or sailing club.
- 2.2 Skippers and Crews are required to be financial members of a yacht or sailing club.
- 2.3 RQYS Team Racing Membership is not accepted for this series.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter for the series or on a casual basis. Series entries can be made by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee to:

3. FEES

Required fees are as follows:
Series Entry Double Handed Class - \$50.00
Series Entry Single Handed Class - \$40.00
Casual Entry - \$15.00 per week

5. MEASUREMENTS

Each class shall abide by their class rules with regards to Measurements.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available from 0900 on Saturday 16th May. The Sailing Instructions may be emailed to all pre-registered competitors prior to the 16th May at the discretion of the Marine Sports Manager.

7. VENUE

- 7.1 The host club is Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron – 578 Royal Esplanade Manly QLD 4179.
- 7.2 Racing will be conducted on Moreton Bay west of Green Island.

8. THE COURSES

The diagram in Attachment 1 shows the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 9.2 Four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 (a) When 6 or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races scores.
(b) When 7 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst result.
(c) When 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two results.
- 9.4 VYC Yardsticks will apply to all boats with fewer than five series entries of the same class.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

11. PRIZES & DIVISIONS

- 11.1 Scratch / VYC– 1st in each division/class.
- 11.2 Handicap – 1st in each division/class.
- 11.3 Five series entries of the same class will constitute a division.
- 11.4 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the race committee.

12. DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

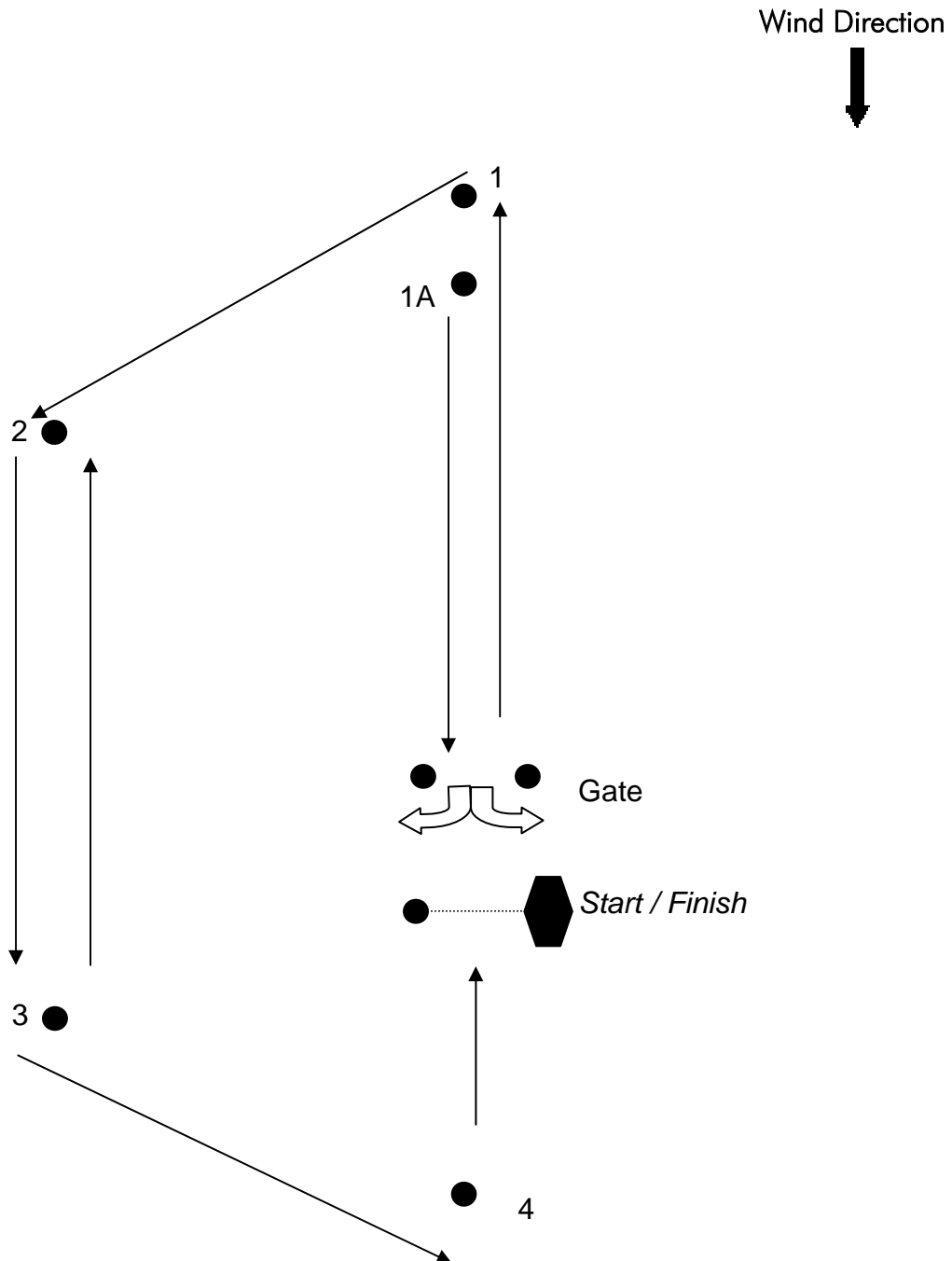
Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5m per event or equivalent.
