



# FIRE EMERGENCY PROCEDURES ROYAL QLD YACHT SQUADRON

Action to be taken following the discovery of a **FIRE** on a boat in the marina, hardstand, boat ramp or a boat at the fuel pontoon.

1. Shout loudly into the boat and account for ALL persons, if boat is on the fuel pontoon shut down all fuel and electricity supply, if on the marina shut down the electricity supply.

## 2. TELEPHONE 000 and advise QUEENSLAND FIRE and RESCUE that:

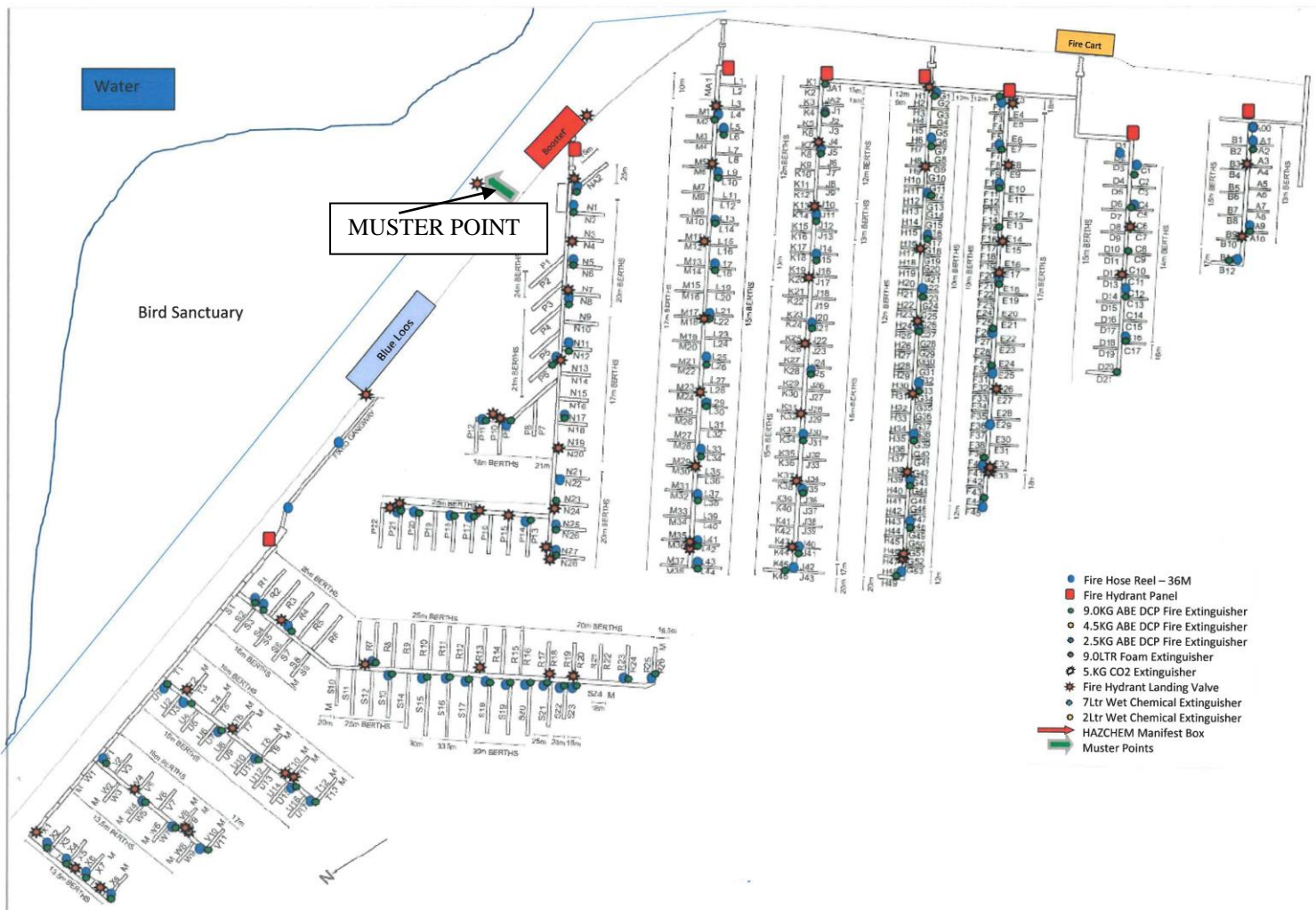
- There is a boat on fire at the Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron at Manly Boat Harbour.
- Describe the location within the marina (berth number, marina row, hardstand location, boat ramp, fuel pontoon) as accurately as possible.
- Describe the class of fire (fibreglass, wood, gas electrical, fuel etc) as accurately as possible.
- Advise if there are any injuries, and the possible severity of the injuries.
- Describe any hazardous conditions near the fire.
- Advise what fire fighting efforts, if any, are already in progress.

## 3. IF SAFELY POSSIBLE

- Use all available fire-fighting equipment until the Fire Service arrives. (Fire hose reels and extinguishers are installed on all marina walkways)
- Move adjacent boats away from the fire area to create a fire-break.
- If on the marina, secure the burning boat to the marina with chain.

## NEVER CUT THE BURNING VESSEL ADrift OR TOW IT AWAY FROM THE BERTH

- Keep spectators well away – burning boat may explode



5. Ensure that Fire Service vehicles have clear access to the fire – open the access gates, remove vehicles near fire hydrants, boosters, link bridges etc.
