### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australia Sailing Inc. (AS) – Part 1 Category 5.
- 1.3 Where lifelines complying with AS SR Part 1 Section 3 Rule 3.12 have not been fitted, all crew while racing shall wear a visible personal floatation device as per AS SR Part 1 Section 5.
- 1.4 IRC, OMR and SMS rules shall apply to those yachts sailing under the relevant measurement rule.

### 2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all monohull and multihull boats on the register of a yacht or sailing club affiliated with a Member National Authority.
- 3.2 Entries can be lodged online at <https://www.topyacht.com.au/db/kb/1238>
- 3.3 Entries are to be received by Wednesday, 13 May 2020.
- 3.4 Late entries will incur an additional entry fee and will be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority.

### 4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee for all boats shall be \$35.00 which includes 1 dinner ticket for each boat.
- 4.2 Food at Canaipa shall be at an additional cost – more information will be released shortly. [Additional food tickets to be purchased here.](#)

**6 CATEGORIES & DIVISIONS**

6.1 Categories will be constituted when four (4) or more boats are entered a category.

6.2 Viable categories are:

OMR;

IRC;

PHS Monohull;

PHS Multihull;

& Short-Handed in any of the above

**7 MEASUREMENTS**

7.1 Each eligible IRC boat shall produce a current IRC Certificate or they should be available [online here](#).

7.2 Each eligible OMR or SMS boat shall produce a valid and current measurement/rating certificate.

**8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available from the RQYS Sailing Office and [online](#) by Thursday, 14 May 2020.

**9 VENUE**

The host club is The Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron, while the regatta will be between RQYS in Manly and RQYS Canaipa, Russell Island.

**10 THE COURSES**

Full courses descriptions will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

**11 SCORING**

11.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2 There will be no drops in this regatta.

**12 BERTHING / HARDSTAND**

For RQYS Marina Berths or Hardstand spaces please contact the Marina Office on 07 3393 3554 during business hours. Some berthing will also be provided for boats drawing less than 2.4m at the RQYS Bill Kirby Jetty adjacent to the clubhouse – bookings for these berths are ESSENTIAL and to be booked with RQYS Reception. Boats that live away from Manly and RQYS Members will be prioritized.

**13 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

13.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13.2 It is a condition of entry that all boats must have full capability of communicating with the Race Committee on VHF 72 if required.

**14 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each PHS, IRC and SMS, when categories have four (4) or more entries. Boats may enter more than one (1) category.

**15 DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**16 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10m per event or equivalent.
