## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing Inc. (AS) – Part 1 Category 5. See NOR 2.4.
- 1.3 Where lifelines complying with AS SR Part 1 Section 3 Rule 3.12 have not been fitted, all crew while racing shall wear a visible personal floatation device as per AS SR Part 1 Section 5.
- 1.4 IRC and OMR rules shall apply to those yachts sailing under the measurement rule.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Monohull and Multihull boats on the register of the Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron.
- 2.2 Entries can be lodged [online here](#).
- 2.3 All vessels currently entered in the Squadron Division Yachts Seasons Points are automatically entered in this event.
- 2.4 SR Category 5 Audits are required to be handed in, signed-off by a National Equipment Auditor, to the sailing office for a boat to be eligible to compete.

## 7 VENUE

The host club is The Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron.

## 8 THE COURSE & RACE AREA

8.1 The course will be published as an amendment to the 135<sup>th</sup> Sailing Season (2019/20) Sailing Instructions.

8.2 The race area will be in the vicinity of Myora and will go around Peel Island.

## 9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## 10 PRIZES & DIVISIONS

Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each division.

## 11 DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10m per event or equivalent.
