#### INTRODUCTION

The Goodwill Cup Sailing Regatta is a chance for sailors to come together and celebrate friendship and friendly competition between clubs, boats, and sailors. While racing is a focus, fun and enjoyment of sailing is the goal of the event with a chance to enjoy on and off water comradery.

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australia Sailing (AS) – Part 1 Category 5.
- 1.3 Where lifelines complying with AS SR Part 1 Section 3 Rule 3.12 have not been fitted, all crew while racing shall wear a visible personal floatation device as per AS SR Part 1 Section 5.
- 1.4 IRC, OMR and SMS rules shall apply to those yachts sailing under the relevant measurement rule.

#### 2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all Monohull and Multihull boats on the register of a yacht or sailing club affiliated with a Member National Authority.
- 3.2 Entries can be made via the Online Entry link <https://app.sailsys.com.au/club/25/profile?tab=results> and are to be received by 2359 hours on 11 November 2020.
- 3.3 Late entries may be accepted past 2359 hours on Saturday 14 November 2020 when received with the additional late fee (NOR 4).

#### 4 FEES

All boats - \$80.00  
Late entry – Additional \$50.00

#### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions (including courses) will be available from the RQYS Sailing Office and online from Friday 13 November 2020.

## 7 DIVISIONS

7.1 There shall be four (4) divisions:

Division 1 for IRC and Performance Yachts (PHS and IRC)

Division 2 for Cruising Non-Spinnaker (PHS)

Division 3 for Trailerable Boats and Small Yachts (PHS and SMS)

Division 4 for Multihulls (PHS and OMR)

## 8 SCORING

8.1 One (1) race is required to constitute a Regatta.

8.2 There will be no drops in the Regatta.

## 9 BERTHING / HARDSTAND

For RQYS Marina Berths or Hardstand spaces please contact the Marina Office on 07 3393 3554 during business hours. Some berthing will also be provided for boats drawing less than 2.3m at the RQYS Bill Kirby Jetty adjacent to the clubhouse, which must be booked by contacting the club.

## 10 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for:

- a. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in all Divisions where more than five (5) boats are entered.
- b. The Goodwill Cup will be presented to 1<sup>st</sup> in Division 1 IRC.
- c. The WDM Taylor Memorial Trophy will be presented to 1<sup>st</sup> in Division 2 PHS.
- d. The Lord Brassey Cup will be presented to 1<sup>st</sup> in Division 1 PHS.

## 11 DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or equivalent.
