NOTICE OF RACE

(NoR)

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 RRS Appendix 5.3 will Apply.
- 1.3 The Australian Sailing prescriptions and special regulations of Australian Sailing (AS) Part 1 Category 5 will apply.
- 1.4 Competitors must comply with Qld Government COVID-19 contact tracing via the electronic app "Check in Qld".
- 1.5 The RQYS Constitution, Club Participation Rules (See NoR Attachment C), House Rules and Codes of Conduct will apply.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 1600 on 11/09/2021 at <https://www.rqys.com.au/sailingnoticeboard/> .

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at <https://www.rqys.com.au/sailingnoticeboard/> .
- 3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Seasons entry is open to Yachts owned by financial members of the Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron.
- 4.2 Seasons Entrants will be entered in the **Season Points** Series, as well as the **Squadron Championships** providing there are enough entries in the division.
- 4.3 Skippers and Crew with seasons entries are required to be financial members of the Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron in the appropriate category.
- 4.4 Casual Entries can be lodged in advance by contacting RQYS Sailing on 07 3396 8666 or sailing@rqys.com.au, or, can be lodged on the day of racing before the first warning signal of the day, by seeing the Sailing Office staff upstairs in the Marine Sports Amenities Building.
- 4.5 Casual entrants are required to be a member of Australian Sailing by having a club membership with a yacht or sailing club, or by obtaining an RQYS Sail Pass. See NoR Attachment C for further rules regarding day-pass membership.
- 4.6 Boats may enter the event by registering online at <https://app.sailsys.com.au/club/25/entry/series/1276/pricing> .
- 4.7 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.8 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

6. DIVISIONS

- 6.1 Divisions 1, 2 and 3 shall be split as follows
 - 6.1 (a) Division 1: 1.000 and above
 - 6.1 (b) Division 2: 0.900 to 0.999
 - 6.1 (c) Division 3: 0.899 and below
 - 6.1 (d) Division 4: Cruising (casual Entries only)
 - 6.1 (e) Division 5: Multihull
- 6.2 Divisions may be combined based on number of entries.

7. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

8. SCHEDULE

- 8.1 Opening Day of the 137th Season (2021 – 2022) shall be on Saturday 11 September 2021. Racing will be a mix of Saturdays and Sundays, in accordance with the Sailing Program published online.
- 8.2 **Opening Day Race on Saturday 11 September 2021** shall be run as a separate race to Seasons Points with a separate set of Sailing Instructions.
- 8.3 Seasons Points races will be every race of the Season.
- 8.4 Squadron Championships races will be as per the [Sailing Program](#).

9. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 9.1 Boats may be inspected at any time.

10. VENUE

- 10.1 NoR Attachment A shows the plan of the event venue.

11. COURSES

- 11.1 The courses shall be described in the 2021/22 Course Booklets as provided by the RQYS Sailing Office, published online on the [Club Racing](#) website by Opening Day, 11 September 2021.
- 11.2 When racing is combined with MCC the [MCC Course Book](#) shall amend NoR 10.1.

12. SCORING

- 12.1 The number of races required to constitute a series and the number of discard allowed shall be as follows;
 - 12.1 (a) Squadron Championship: 10 races (1 discard after 4 completed races, 2 discards after 8 completed races).
 - 12.1 (b) Seasons Points: 16 races (1 discard after 4 completed races, additional 1 discard after every additional 4 completed races).
 - 12.1 (c) Passage Races Series': 10 races (1 discard after 4 completed races, 2 discards after 8 completed races).
 - 12.1 (d) Round the Cans Series: 6 races (1 discard after 4 completed races)
- 12.2 A boat which Does Not Compete (DNC) in a race shall be scored the number competitors within the fleet at the starting area, plus an additional three (3) points. This changes RRS A5.3 .

13. BERTHING

- 13.1 [NP] No vessels shall berth or rig on the RQYS Fuel Dock unless re-fuelling or approval from the RQYS Marina Office.
- 13.2 For RQYS Marina Berths or use of the VIP Docks, please contact the RQYS Marina Office on 3396 8666 during business hours.

14. RISK STATEMENT

- 14.1 RRS 4 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

15. INSURANCE

- 15.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000AUD per incident or the equivalent.

16. PRIZES

- 16.1 The 2021/2022 Presentations of Trophies for Seasons Points and Squadron Championships and other events will take place in a Squadron Function Room, to be advised by invitation in future. A list of major trophies is at Attachment B.
- 16.2 Only Season Entrants are eligible for Seasons Points or Squadron Championship awards at the Senior Presentation of Trophies.
- 16.3 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

Attachment C

Club Participation Rules

- Following participation with a RQYS Sail Pass Membership (or sailing membership to another club) in any twelve (12) Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron Ltd. (RQYS) races other than invitation events, any owner or skipper of a participating boat with a Casual Entry, is required to become a member, in the appropriate category, of RQYS.
- Non-member Crew can sail up to twelve (12) times with a RQYS Sail Pass Membership (or participate with sailing membership to another club) before they are required to become a member, in the appropriate category, of RQYS.
- Only current financial members of the Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron (in the correct category of Membership) are eligible for a Season Entry.
- It is the responsibility of the owner/skipper to ensure that all crew competing on the boat hold a current membership of Australian Sailing or equivalent membership of a yachting authority recognised by World Sailing (RQYS Day Pass or Sailing Membership of another club), and the boat has \$10,000,000 third party insurance for the duration of racing or being on the RQYS premises.
- All members intending to race shall pre-pay and register with a Season Entry or Casual Entry prior to racing. Failure to pay the outlined fee and/or register shall result in positions not being recorded and forfeited by the competitor. Members who continue to race without paying or registering shall be disciplined by General Committee.
