## Race Committee Composition Policy

- 1. The "Default" Race Committee at the Squadron is composed of the Flag Officers, Sailing Committee Chair, Sailing Manager.
- 2. A separate Race Committee may be composed for specific events and shall be outlined in the Notice of Race, Sailing Instructions, or by some other means of Communication.
- 3. Where a Race Course is being run by a Race Officer that Race Officer shall be immediately on the Race Committee unless specifically excluded.
- 4. The Race Committee on the day shall be those immediately present.
- 5. **Any member of the Race Committee may call a Stop to any activity** in the event, series, or race to which they are a member of the committee for any reason.
  - a. For example a Race Officer may elect to Abandon Racing immediately if they perceive imminent danger to Volunteers, Sailors or Vessels such as Lightning.
- 6. Any specific decision that does not warrant a Stop shall be considered by 2 members of the Race Committee
  - a. For example a Race Officer conducting racing may consult with the Sailing Manager prior to abandoning Racing for the day if they are concerned by developing weather.
- 7. Any decisions in relation to non-immediate considerations shall be made by 3 or more members of the Race Committee if practicable.
  - a. For example a change to Sailing Instructions for Club Racing that will take effect from the following weekend should involve consultation with multiple members of the committee.
