NOTICE OF RACE (NoR)

ORGANISING AUTHORITY

ROYAL QUEENSLAND YACHT SQUADRON LTD 578 Royal Esplanade, Manly, QLD 4179

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

The notation [DP] in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of the rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee be less than disqualification. This changes Rule 64.2

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.
- 1.2 The Australian Sailing prescriptions and special regulations include (AS) Part 1 Category 5.
- 1.3 Where lifelines complying with ASSR Part 1 Section 3 Rule 3.12 have not been fitted, all crew while racing shall wear a visible personal floatation device as per ASSR Part 1 Section 5.
- 1.4 IRC and OMR rules shall apply to those yachts sailing under the relevant measurement rule.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 1200 hrs on 22/05/2024 on the Official Notice Board.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at https://www.rgys.com.au/canaipa-cup-2024/.
- 3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channel 72, 77 & 16.
- 3.3 [DP] While racing except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Monohull and Multihull boats on the register of a yacht or sailing club affiliated with a Member National Authority.
- 4.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online at https://www.rqys.com.au/canaipa-cup-2024/
- 4.3 Entries are to be received by Thursday 22 May 2024.

5. FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee for all boats shall be \$60.00
- 5.2 Food at Canaipa shall be at an additional cost:
- 5.2 (a) 2 Course Dinner Starting 1800hrs, \$30.00 per adult & \$15.00 per child 15 and younger.
- 5.2 (b) Breakfast Rolls 0730 0830hrs, \$12.50 per person
- 5.2 (c) Food Tickets must be purchased online <u>HERE</u> before 12PM 22nd May 2024, <u>no</u> tickets will be sold on the island.

^{7.2} No Warning Signal shall be made after 1300 hrs on each day of racing.

8. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

8.1 Each boat entered in either IRC or OMR shall produce or verify the existence of a valid rating (IRC or OMR) certificate.

9. VENUE

9.1 The host club is The Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron, while the regatta will be between RQYS in Manly and RQYS Canaipa, Russell Island.

10. COURSES

10.1 The courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 One (1) race is required to constitute a series.
- 11.2 There will be no drops for the Regatta.

12. BERTHING

12.1 For RQYS Marina Berths or Hardstand spaces please contact the Marina Office on 07 3393 3554 during business hours. Some berthing will also be provided for boats drawing less than 2.4m at the RQYS Bill Kirby Jetty adjacent to the clubhouse–bookings for these berths are **ESSENTIAL** and to be booked with RQYS Marina Office. Boats that live away from Manly Harbour and RQYS Members will be prioritized.

13. DATA PROTECTION

13.1 By participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for said event in which the competitor participated and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

14. RISK STATEMENT

- 14.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 14.2 All participants are required to comply with any safety provisions as mandated under the Racing Rules of Sailing, and any Class Rules that may apply. The Squadron encourages and supports competitors who believe it is appropriate to exceed the above requirements (such as the wearing of helmets, body armor, impact vests, etc.) if they or their guardian believe that conditions and their personal circumstances warrant. All competitor's attention is drawn to the Risk Statement Section 14 of the Notice of Race.

15. INSURANCE

15.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per incident or the equivalent.

16. PRIZES

- 16.1 Prizes will be given as follows:
- 16.2 The Canaipa Cup shall be awarded for 1st Place Monohull on PHS.
- 16.3 1st, 2nd and 3rd Monohull PHS
- 16.4 1st, 2nd and 3rd Monohull IRC
- 16.5 1st, 2nd and 3rd Monohull Cruising PHS
- 16.6 1st, 2nd and 3rd Multihull PHS
- 16.7 1st, 2nd and 3rd Multihull OMR
- 16.8 1st, 2nd and 3rd Trailerable PHS
- 16.9 1st, 2nd and 3rd Trailerable CBH
- 16.10 Daily Prizes will be awarded to:
 - 16.10 (a) 1st, 2nd & 3rd for each subseries.
- 16.11 Boats may enter more than one handicap division.
- 16.12 5 or more entries are required to constitute a division.
- 16.13 Other prizes may be awarded by the Organising Authority.
