NOTICE OF RACE

Including Amendment 1

The Organising Authority is the Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron on behalf of Pacer Queensland. The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule.

This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.
- 1.2 The Australian Sailing prescriptions and special regulations Part 2 apply.
- 1.3 The Team Racing Rules (Appendix D of the RRS) apply.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 1200 hrs on 27/4/2024 on the Regatta Official Notice Board.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located Here
- 3.2 [NP] From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 All competitors (both skipper and crew) shall be members of a yacht/sailing club affiliated with Australian Sailing in accordance with RRS 46.
- 4.2 The maximum number of entries will be limited to ten (10) teams.
- 4.3 A team shall consist of six to eight competitors and any combination of six competitors may compete in any race.
- 4.4 Eligible Teams may nominate entry by downloading and completing the linked form(s) and sending back to sailing@rqys.com.au by 1200 Wednesday 13th April 2024.

5. FEES

5.1 The Entry fee shall be \$300.00 per team. A damage deposit of \$100.00 (per team) will be included in the entry fee, making the total payable \$400.00.

6. SUPPLIED BOATS

- 6.1 The boats to be used till be Pacer Dinghy class boats supplied by Pacer Queensland.
- 6.2 12 boats will be provided, teams will rotate between boats.
- 6.3 One Mainsail and Jib will be provided with each boat.
- 6.4 Boats will be allocated as per the round robin draw or as decided by the race committee.

7. ADVERTISING

7.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

9. VENUE

- 9.2 NoR Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

10. COURSES

10.1 The course(s) to be sailed will be an "S" configuration which will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 The scoring format will be described in the Sailing Instructions, the tentative format of racing is:
- 11.1 (a) Round Robin Racing of at least 1 round.
- 11.1 (b) The Top 4 teams will enter a semi finals series (best of 3 races).
- 11.1 (c) Grand Finals & Petite Finals (best of 3 races).
- 11.2 The Organising Authority reserves the right to alter the format at any time.

12. RISK STATEMENT

- 12.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 12.2 All participants are required to comply with any safety provisions as mandated under the Racing Rules of Sailing, the Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 for Off The Beach Boats, and any Class Rules that may apply. The Squadron encourages and supports competitors who believe it is appropriate to exceed the above requirements (such as the wearing of helmets, body armor, impact vests, etc.) if they or their guardian believe that conditions and their personal circumstances warrant. All competitor's attention is drawn to the Risk Statement Section 12 of the Notice of Race.

13. INSURANCE

13.1 Pacer Queensland will ensure each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per incident or the equivalent.

14. PRIZES

- 14.1 Prizes will be given as follows:
 - 1st, 2nd & 3rd teams overall.
- 14.2 Prizes will be distributed at the discretion of the organising authority and may vary depending on the number of entries.
